Our Recent Initiatives:

Sustainability Policy

We have developed and implemented a comprehensive sustainability policy that reflects our dedication to minimizing our environmental footprint and fostering a culture of responsible business practices. We joined the Travelife program and are in the process of getting the sustainability certificate.

Action Plan

We have developed a strategic action plan with clear and measurable goals for the next two years to guide our sustainability efforts. We are committed to regularly evaluating our progress and making necessary adjustments to achieve improvement.

Office Initiatives

We are most proud of the fact that we've gone completely paperless in our operations, reducing our reliance on traditional paper documents and promoting digital alternatives to minimize environmental impact. Besides, we have implemented new software and digitalized our reservations system which saved us approx. 700 working hours, lowering energy consumption (and quite some other resources) in the 2023 season.
